In addition to his litigation practice, Mr. Gilreath is also available to assist clients with their estate planning needs.



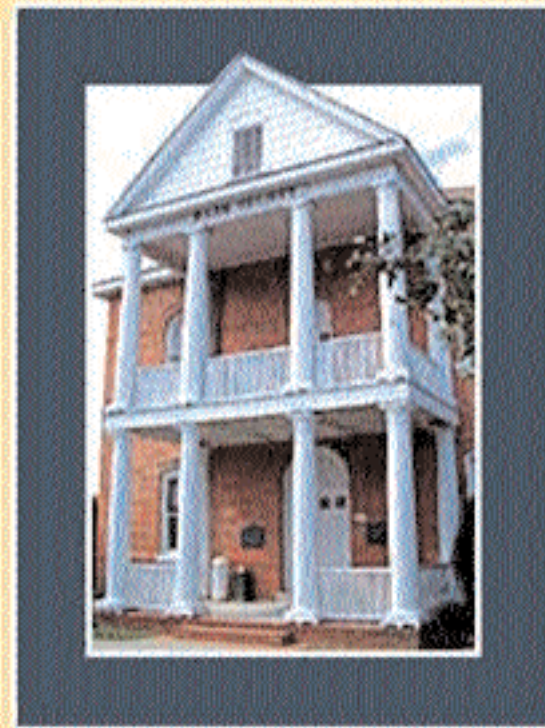
